CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Law - Businesses and Associations - Federal Identification Number**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain businesses and associations to include a federal  
4 identification number on an application for a certificate of title of a vehicle.

5 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
6 Article - Transportation  
7 Section 13-104(a)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Transportation**

2 13-104.

3 (a) The application for a certificate of title of a vehicle shall be made by the  
4 owner of the vehicle on the form that the Administration requires.

5 (c) The application shall contain:

6 (1) The full name and Maryland address of the owner, including:

7 (i) If the owner is an individual, the owner's Maryland residence  
8 and mailing addresses;

9 (ii) If the owner is a business firm, association, or corporation, its  
10 ~~business address in this State or the name and address of a resident agent in this~~  
11 ~~State AND ITS FEDERAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER~~ FEDERAL IDENTIFICATION  
12 NUMBER AND:

13 1. ITS BUSINESS ADDRESS IN THIS STATE; OR

14 2. THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF ITS RESIDENT AGENT IN  
15 THIS STATE;

16 (iii) If the owner is a partnership or joint venture, the name of each  
17 partner or joint venturer;

18 (iv) If the owner is an unincorporated association, joint stock  
19 company, or other group described in § 6-406 of the Courts Article, the name and  
20 address of a resident agent on whom service may be made in any law suit arising out  
21 of the ownership, maintenance, or use of the vehicle; and

22 (v) If the owner is a trustee, the address of the trust in this State  
23 and the name and address of a person in this State on whom service may be made in  
24 any law suit arising out of the ownership, maintenance, or use of the vehicle;

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
26 effect October 1, 2000.
