15 (a) (1) After each election, each board of canvassers shall transmit one 16 certified copy of the election results in its county, attested by the signatures of the 17 chairperson and secretary of the board of canvassers, to:

- 1 (iii) The clerk of the circuit court for the appropriate county. 2 (2) The statement may be mailed or delivered in person. 3 (B) AFTER EACH GENERAL ELECTION IN WHICH VOTES HAVE BEEN CAST FOR 4 A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE, EACH BOARD OF CANVASSERS SHALL TRANSMIT A 5 STATEMENT OF RETURNS OF THE VOTES CAST FOR WRITE-IN CANDIDATES WHO 6 HAVE FILED A CERTIFICATE OF CANDIDACY. 7 The transmittal shall be made on the second Friday after a [(b)](C) (1) 8 primary or general election or, if the canvass is completed after that date, within 48 9 hours after the completion of the canvass.
- 10 (2) After a special primary or special election, the transmittal shall be 11 made as soon as possible, but no later than the second Thursday after the election.
- 12 [(c)] (D) The clerk of the circuit court shall enter of record the election results 13 filed with the court under this section.
