

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**
- 14 1-101.
- 15 In this Division I of this article the following words have the meanings (a) 16 indicated.
- "Appointing authority" means an individual or a unit of government that 17 18 has the power to make appointments and terminate employment.
- "Class" means a category of one or more similar positions, as established 19
- 20 by the Secretary in accordance with this article.
- "Contractual employee" means an individual described in § 13-101 of this 21 (d)
- 22 article.
- 23 (e) "County" means a county of this State and, unless expressly provided
- 24 otherwise, Baltimore City.



- $1\,$ SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 2 effect October 1, 2000.
