3 FOR the purpose of making it a misdemeanor for a person, in a matter within the

- 4 jurisdiction of a unit of the Legislative Branch of the State government, to
- 5 knowingly and willfully falsify or conceal a material fact, make a false, fictitious,
- 6 or fraudulent representation, or make or use a document that contains a false,
- 7 fictitious, or fraudulent representation; making this Act applicable only to
- 8 certain recorded hearings and proceedings; imposing a penalty for this offense;
- 9 defining a certain term; and generally relating to false statements to Legislative
- 10 Branch units.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "UNIT" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES OF 21 THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT:

SENATE BILL 88

1 (1) A STANDING COMMITTEE AS DEFINED IN § 2-101(F) OF THIS TITLE 2 OR A SUBCOMMITTEE OF A STANDING COMMITTEE;

3 (2) A LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE CREATED BY STATUTE OR A 4 SUBCOMMITTEE OF A LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE;

5 (3) THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE OR A SPECIAL COMMITTEE 6 APPOINTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE UNDER § 2-407(B)(3) OF THIS 7 TITLE; OR

8 (4) ANY OTHER TASK FORCE OR COMMITTEE APPOINTED BY THE 9 LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE OR THE PRESIDING OFFICER OF THE HOUSE OR 10 SENATE.

(B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO HEARINGS OR OTHER PROCEEDINGS OF A
 UNIT THAT ARE REQUIRED TO BE RECORDED BY THE RULES OF THE HOUSE OR
 SENATE.

14 (C) A PERSON MAY NOT, IN A MATTER WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF A UNIT, 15 KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY:

16 (1) FALSIFY OR CONCEAL A MATERIAL FACT;

17 (2) MAKE A FALSE, FICTITIOUS, OR FRAUDULENT REPRESENTATION; OR

18 (3) MAKE OR USE A DOCUMENT THAT CONTAINS A FALSE, FICTITIOUS,19 OR FRAUDULENT REPRESENTATION.

20 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
21 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000 OR
22 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 24 October 1, 2000.
