SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (c) The governing body of Prince George's County may grant, by law, a 19 property tax credit under this section against the county property tax or special 20 district tax imposed on:
