A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Crimes - Masks and Hoods - Prohibitions**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain persons from wearing, in certain locations, a
4 mask, hood, or other device which covers a substantial portion of the face with
5 the intent to conceal identity; establishing certain exceptions; establishing a
6 certain penalty; and generally relating to prohibiting the wearing of masks,
7 hoods, or other devices.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments**

16 580B.

17 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON
18 MAY NOT, WITH THE INTENT TO CONCEAL THE IDENTITY OF THE PERSON, WEAR A
19 MASK, HOOD, OR OTHER DEVICE THAT COVERS A SUBSTANTIAL PORTION OF THE
20 FACE, IN A PUBLIC PLACE OR ON PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN CONSENT
21 OF THE PROPERTY OWNER.

22 (B) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A PERSON WHO:

23 (1) IS UNDER THE AGE OF 17 YEARS;

24 (2) WEARS A TRADITIONAL HOLIDAY COSTUME;

25 (3) WEARS A PROTECTIVE MASK, HOOD, OR OTHER DEVICE IN THE
26 COURSE OF A PROFESSION, TRADE, EMPLOYMENT, OR SPORTS ACTIVITY;

1 (4) ENGAGES IN A BONA FIDE THEATRICAL PRODUCTION OR
2 MASQUERADE BALL;

3 (5) WEARS A MASK, HOOD, OR OTHER DEVICE FOR A BONA FIDE
4 MEDICAL REASON; OR

5 (6) WEARS A MASK, HOOD, OR OTHER DEVICE AS:

6 (I) PROTECTION FROM THE COLD;

7 (II) AN EXPRESSION OF GRIEF; OR

8 (III) A PART OF THE PRACTICE OF A RELIGION.

9 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND, ON
10 CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A FINE
11 NOT EXCEEDING \$2,500 OR BOTH.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2000.
