- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain persons from wearing, in certain locations, a
- 4 mask, hood, or other device which covers a substantial portion of the face with
- 5 the intent to conceal identity; establishing certain exceptions; establishing a
- 6 certain penalty; and generally relating to prohibiting the wearing of masks,
- 7 hoods, or other devices.

## 15 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- 17 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON
- 18 MAY NOT, WITH THE INTENT TO CONCEAL THE IDENTITY OF THE PERSON, WEAR A
- 19 MASK, HOOD, OR OTHER DEVICE THAT COVERS A SUBSTANTIAL PORTION OF THE
- 20 FACE, IN A PUBLIC PLACE OR ON PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN CONSENT
- 21 OF THE PROPERTY OWNER.
