10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

13 8-109.

14 The Committee consists of the following [5] 7 members:

- 15 (1) 1 individual appointed by the Governor; and
- 16 (2) as ex officio members:
 - 17 (i) the Comptroller;
 - 18 (ii) the Treasurer;

1 (iii) the Secretary of Budget and Management; [and]

2 (iv) the Secretary of Transportation[.];

3 (V) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION
4 COMMITTEE; AND

5 (VI) THE CHAIRMAN OF THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 July 1, 2000.
