A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Baltimore Wine Festival**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the license fee for the Baltimore Wine Festival; extending  
4 the period during which a Baltimore Wine Festival may be conducted; and  
5 generally relating to the Baltimore Wine Festival.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
7 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
8 Section 8-303(a)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
12 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
13 Section 8-303(d) and (f)  
14 Annotated Code of Maryland  
15 (1998 Replacement Volume and 1999 Supplement)

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

19 8-303.

20 (a) The Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners may issue up to 4  
21 special Baltimore Wine Festival (BWF) licenses.

22 (d) The license fee is [~~\$15~~] \$ 50 PER DAY.

23 (f) The Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners:

24 (1) May select 4 [weekends] PERIODS annually for a Baltimore Wine  
25 Festival, WITH EACH PERIOD BEGINNING ON THURSDAY AND ENDING ON THE  
26 FOLLOWING SUNDAY;

1                   (2)       Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, shall choose a  
2 location in Baltimore City for a festival for which an alcoholic beverages license has  
3 not been issued; and

4                   (3)       May not issue a license under this section for use in election districts  
5 46 and 47A.

6       SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 October 1, 2000.
