# 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

17 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 18 INDICATED.

19(2)(1)"COMPENSATION" MEANS A FEE OR CHARGE LEVIED AGAINST20AN INDIVIDUAL FOR THE INSTALLATION OR INSPECTION OF A CHILD RESTRAINT

21 DEVICE BY A TRAINED CHILD RESTRAINT DEVICE INSTALLER OR AN ENTITY THAT

22 EMPLOYS A TRAINED CHILD RESTRAINT DEVICE INSTALLER.

1(II)"COMPENSATION" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE WAGES, SALARY, OR2OTHER COMPENSATION PAID BY AN ENTITY THAT EMPLOYS A TRAINED CHILD3RESTRAINT DEVICE INSTALLER.

4 (3) "MOTOR VEHICLE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 11-135 OF THE 5 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.

6 (4) "TRAINED CHILD RESTRAINT <u>DEVICE</u> INSTALLER" MEANS AN
7 INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A COURSE IN CHILD PASSENGER
8 SAFETY THAT MEETS THE TRAINING STANDARDS SET BY THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY
9 TRAFFIC SAFETY ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
10 TRANSPORTATION.

11 (B) A TRAINED CHILD RESTRAINT <u>DEVICE</u> INSTALLER IS NOT CIVILLY LIABLE
12 FOR AN ACT OR OMISSION THAT OCCURS IN THE INSPECTING OR INSTALLING OF A
13 CHILD RESTRAINT DEVICE IN A MOTOR VEHICLE IF:

14 (1) THE TRAINED CHILD RESTRAINT <u>DEVICE</u> INSTALLER ACTS IN GOOD 15 FAITH;

16 (2) THE ACT OR OMISSION IS NOT ONE OF GROSS NEGLIGENCE;

17(3)THE ACT OR OMISSION IS NOT WILLFUL OR WANTON MISCONDUCT;18AND

19(4)THE INSPECTION OR INSTALLATION OF THE CHILD RESTRAINT20DEVICE IS PROVIDED WITHOUT COMPENSATION.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be

22 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect

23 on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of this Act.

24 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 October 1, 2000.
