13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, Notwithstanding the

2 provisions of § 4-303(a) of the Health Occupations Article, the State Board of Dental

3 Examiners may waive the education requirements of § 4-302(d) of the article for a

4 general licensee applicant who meets the criteria provided in § 4-303(b) of the article

5 and was enrolled in a residency program at The University of Maryland Dental

6 School on or before July 1, 1998 and is examined by the State Board of Dental

7 Examiners on or before December 31, 2000.

8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 July 1, 2000.
