A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Teacher Scholarships**

3 FOR the purpose of providing the award amount for the Maryland Teacher  
4 Scholarship Program; and generally relating to the Maryland teacher  
5 scholarships.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Education**

19 18-2202.

20 There is a program of Maryland teacher scholarships that are awarded under  
21 this subtitle for students who pledge to work as public elementary and secondary  
22 school teachers in this State upon completion of their studies.

1 18-2205.

2       The annual scholarship award shall be in the amount of [~~\$1,000~~] \$2,000 for a  
3 student enrolled at a 2-year eligible institution or [~~\$3,000~~] \$5,000 for a student  
4 enrolled in a 4-year eligible institution.

5       SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
6 October 1, 2000.
