CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Teacher Scholarships**

3 FOR the purpose of providing the award amount for the Maryland Teacher
4 Scholarship Program; authorizing a recipient of a Maryland teacher scholarship
5 to be eligible for certain other scholarship assistance; and generally relating to
6 the Maryland teacher scholarships.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education2 18-303.

3 (a) [Except for an economic development student assistance grant awarded
4 under § 18-701 of this title, a Distinguished Scholar Award under § 18-1101 of this
5 title, and a Maryland Science and Technology Scholarship awarded under § 18-2001
6 of this title, the] THE recipient of an Educational Excellence Award may not hold any
7 other scholarship awarded under this title EXCEPT FOR:

8 (1) AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STUDENT ASSISTANCE GRANT
9 AWARDED UNDER § 18-701 OF THIS TITLE;

10 (2) A DISTINGUISHED SCHOLAR AWARDED UNDER § 18-1101 OF THIS
11 TITLE;

12 (3) A MARYLAND SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED
13 UNDER § 18-2001 OF THIS TITLE; AND

14 (4) A MARYLAND TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER § 18-2202 OF
15 THIS TITLE.

16 18-2202.

17 There is a program of Maryland teacher scholarships that are awarded under
18 this subtitle for students who pledge to work as public elementary and secondary
19 school teachers in this State upon completion of their studies.

20 18-2205.

21 The annual scholarship award shall be in the amount of [\$1,000] \$2,000 for a
22 student enrolled at a 2-year eligible institution or [\$3,000] \$5,000 for a student
23 enrolled in a 4-year eligible institution.

24 18-2208.

25 Except for a Distinguished Scholar Award under § 18-1101 of this article OR AN
26 EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE AWARD UNDER § 18-301 OF THIS ARTICLE, the recipient
27 of a Maryland teacher scholarship may not hold any other scholarship awarded under
28 this title.

29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
30 October 1, 2000.
