

(d) "FULL MEMBER" MEANS A PILOT WHO IS LICENSED BY THE BOARD FOR A 8 (e) 9 PERIOD OF 3 YEARS OR MORE. 10 (F) (1) "License" means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license 11 issued by the Board to provide pilotage. 12 "License" includes, unless the context requires otherwise, a limited (2) 13 license OR A SPECIAL DUTY LICENSE. 14 (1) "Licensed pilot" means a pilot who is licensed by the Board to [(f)](G)provide pilotage. 15 "Licensed pilot" includes the holder of a limited license OR A SPECIAL 16 17 DUTY LICENSE. 18 (H) (1) "Limited license" means a license issued by the Board to provide [(g)]pilotage as limited by § 11-407 of this title. 20 "Limited license" includes a 37-foot-draft limited license, a (2) 21 34-foot-draft limited license, and a 28-foot-draft limited license. 22 "LIMITED LICENSE" DOES NOT INCLUDE A SPECIAL DUTY LICENSE. (3)23 [(h)](I) "Pilot" means an individual who provides pilotage. 24 "Provide pilotage" means to pilot a vessel under the provisions [(i)](J) (1) 25 of this title when the vessel is underway on the navigable waters of the State, 26 including when the vessel is towing or being towed by another vessel. 27 "Provide pilotage" [does not include: (2) 28 (i) maneuvering a vessel during berthing or unberthing 29 operations; or 30 (ii) shifting a vessel within a port with tug assistance and a docking 31 master aboard the vessel] INCLUDES A SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENT. 32 (K) "SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENT" MEANS:
