A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws - Duty to Yield Right-of-Way to Buses and School Vehicles**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the driver of a motor vehicle other than an emergency
4 vehicle, a bus, or a school vehicle to yield the right-of-way to a bus or school
5 vehicle if the driver of the bus or school vehicle signals an intention to change
6 lanes or merge into traffic from a stopped, standing, or parked position.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Transportation**

15 21-404.2.

16 THE DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE OTHER THAN AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE, A
17 BUS, OR A SCHOOL VEHICLE SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO A BUS OR SCHOOL
18 VEHICLE IF, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 21-604 OF THIS TITLE, THE DRIVER OF THE BUS
19 OR SCHOOL VEHICLE SIGNALS AN INTENTION TO CHANGE LANES OR MERGE INTO
20 TRAFFIC FROM A STOPPED, STANDING, OR PARKED POSITION.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 2000.
