4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of the Environment to establish and

5 administer a certain registry of voluntary reductions in greenhouse gas

6 emissions for certain purposes; requiring the Department to adopt certain

7 regulations; requiring the Department to conduct a certain study and submit a

8 certain report on or before a certain date; defining certain terms; and generally

9 relating to the establishment of a registry of voluntary reductions in greenhouse

10 gas emissions.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 21 INDICATED.

22 (2) "EMISSION" MEANS A RELEASE INTO THE OUTDOOR ATMOSPHERE 23 OF A GREENHOUSE GAS.

24 (3) "GREENHOUSE GAS" INCLUDES CARBON DIOXIDE, METHANE,
25 NITROUS OXIDE, HYDROFLUOROCARBONS, PERFLUOROCARBONS, AND SULFUR
26 HEXAFLUORIDE.

27 (B) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER A REGISTRY
28 OF VOLUNTARY REDUCTIONS IN GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS IN WHICH A SOURCE

OF A GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSION MAY REGISTER ANY VOLUNTARY REDUCTION IN
 GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS.

3 (2) THE PURPOSE OF THE REGISTRY IS TO HELP SOURCES ESTABLISH A
4 BASELINE AGAINST WHICH ANY FUTURE FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR REDUCING
5 GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS MAY APPLY.

6 (C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS 7 SECTION THAT INCLUDE:

8 (1) INFORMATION, FORMS, PROCEDURES, AND APPLICABLE 9 THRESHOLDS FOR REGISTERING VOLUNTARILY ACHIEVED REDUCTIONS OF 10 GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS;

(2) METHODS AND PROCEDURES FOR CALCULATING, ESTIMATING, OR
 OTHERWISE QUANTIFYING VOLUNTARY REDUCTIONS OF GREENHOUSE GAS
 EMISSIONS;

14 (3) METHODS AND PROCEDURES FOR VERIFYING, WHERE NECESSARY,
15 THAT EMISSIONS REDUCTIONS TO BE REGISTERED HAVE ACTUALLY BEEN
16 ACHIEVED; AND

(4) METHODS AND PROCEDURES FOR DETERMINING OR VERIFYING THE
 0WNERSHIP OF GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS REDUCTIONS TO AVOID DOUBLE
 COUNTING THESE REDUCTIONS.

20 (D) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT A STUDY TO DETERMINE
21 WHETHER CREATING A PARTICULATE MATTER REGISTRY SIMILAR TO THE
22 GREENHOUSE GAS REGISTRY ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS SECTION WOULD PROVIDE
23 AN OVERALL BENEFIT TO THE STATE.

(2) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2000, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
REPORT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE
RESULTS OF THIS STUDY, INCLUDING ANY RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LEGISLATION,
TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE SENATE ECONOMIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS
AND THE HOUSE ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS COMMITTEES OF THE GENERAL
ASSEMBLY.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 October 1, 2000.
