

- 9 Maryland Agricultural Education Foundation, Inc. on the development of a special
- 10 registration plate described under Section 1 of this Act and make the plate available to
- 11 the public at the earliest date practicable, but not later than July 1, 2001.
- 12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October July 1, 2000. It shall remain effective for a period of 6 years and, at the end of
- 14 June 30, 2006, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall
- 15 be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
