A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Medical Assistance Program - Eligibility of Noninstitutionalized Spouses -**
3 **Allowances**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to adopt
5 the maximum resource allowances and maximum monthly personal needs
6 allowances for certain spouses in determining eligibility for the Medical
7 Assistance Program; requiring the Secretary to phase in the maximum resource
8 allowances and maximum monthly personal needs allowances over a certain
9 period; and generally relating to the maximum resource allowances and
10 maximum monthly personal needs allowances for certain spouses in
11 determining eligibility for the Medical Assistance Program.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article - Health - General**

20 15-133.

21 (A) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT INCORPORATE THE
22 MAXIMUM RESOURCE ALLOWANCES AND MAXIMUM MONTHLY PERSONAL NEEDS
23 ALLOWANCES FOR NONINSTITUTIONALIZED SPOUSES OF PERSONS WHO RESIDE IN
24 AN INPATIENT MEDICAL FACILITY OR SPOUSES PARTICIPATING IN THE MEDICAID
25 WAIVER PROGRAM IN DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY UNDER THE PROGRAM IN
26 ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL REGULATIONS ADOPTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 42
27 U.S.C. § 1396.

1 (B) THE SECRETARY SHALL PHASE IN THE MAXIMUM RESOURCE ALLOWANCE
2 PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SECTION ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:

3 (1) 35% OF THE MAXIMUM PROTECTED SPOUSAL RESOURCE
4 ALLOWANCE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002;

5 (2) 70% OF THE MAXIMUM PROTECTED SPOUSAL RESOURCE
6 ALLOWANCE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003; AND

7 (3) 100% OF THE MAXIMUM PROTECTED SPOUSAL RESOURCE
8 ALLOWANCE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004.

9 (C) THE SECRETARY SHALL PHASE IN THE MAXIMUM MONTHLY PERSONAL
10 NEEDS ALLOWANCE PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SECTION ACCORDING TO THE
11 FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:

12 (1) 75% OF THE MAXIMUM PROTECTED SPOUSAL INCOME ALLOWANCE
13 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002;

14 (2) 85% OF THE MAXIMUM PROTECTED SPOUSAL INCOME ALLOWANCE
15 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003; AND

16 (3) 100% OF THE MAXIMUM PROTECTED SPOUSAL INCOME ALLOWANCE
17 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2000.
