CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Veterans Commission - Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of adding a representative from the Maryland Coalition of the  
4 Retired Enlisted Association to the Maryland Veterans Commission; and  
5 generally relating to the Maryland Veterans Commission.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article - State Government  
8 Section 9-907  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (1999 Replacement Volume)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - State Government**

14 9-907.

15 (a) (1) The Commission consists of the following [28] 29 members:

16 (i) as an ex officio member, the Chairman of the Maryland  
17 Veterans' Home Commission; and

18 (ii) [27] 28 members appointed by the Governor.

19 (2) Of the [27] 28 appointed members:

1 (i) 1 shall be appointed from each of the 8 congressional districts in  
2 the State;

3 (ii) 1 shall be appointed from the State at large;

4 (iii) 1 shall be a representative of a women veterans organization in  
5 the State; and

6 (iv) 1 shall be appointed from a list of individuals submitted to the  
7 Governor by each of the following organizations:

8 1. the American Ex-Prisoners of War, Inc.;

9 2. the American Legion;

10 3. the Amvets;

11 4. the Catholic War Veterans;

12 5. the Disabled American Veterans;

13 6. the Fleet Reserve Association;

14 7. the Jewish War Veterans;

15 8. the Marine Corps League;

16 9. the Maryland Retired Officers Association;

17 10. the Military Order of the Purple Heart;

18 11. the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association;

19 12. the Polish Legion of American Veterans;

20 13. the Veterans of Foreign Wars;

21 14. the Veterans of World War I;

22 15. the Vietnam Veterans of America;

23 16. the Korean War Veterans Association, Inc.; [and]

24 17. the Black Veterans of All Wars, Inc.; AND

25 18. THE MARYLAND COALITION OF THE RETIRED ENLISTED  
26 ASSOCIATION.

27 (b) Each member must be a resident of the State and a veteran whose final  
28 separation from active service with a uniformed service of the United States was  
29 under honorable conditions.

1 (c) (1) The term of an appointed member is 7 years.

2 (2) The terms of the appointed members are staggered as required by the  
3 terms provided for members of the Commission on October 1, 1984.

4 (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is  
5 appointed and qualifies.

6 (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for  
7 the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 October 1, 2000.
