- (2) The terms of the appointed members are staggered as required by the 3 terms provided for members of the Commission on October 1, 1984.

The term of an appointed member is 7 years.

- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is 5 appointed and qualifies.
- A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for 6 (4) 7 the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 9 October 1, 2000.
