AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the regular and substitute members of the Baltimore City Board of Elections or Baltimore City election judges in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the regular and substitute members of the Baltimore City Board of Elections and Baltimore City election judges shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.
