13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17	(a) There is a Victim and Witness Protection and Relocation Program.
20	(b) The Program shall be administered by the State's Attorneys' Coordinator under Article 10, § 41B of the Code in accordance with regulations adopted by the State's Attorneys' Coordination Council under Article 10, § 41D of the Code after consultation with the State Board of Victim Services.
22	(c) Money appropriated to the Program shall be used to:
23 24	(1) Protect victims and witnesses and the families of victims and witnesses;
25 26	(2) [Relocate] ASSIST victims and witnesses for the purpose of protecting them or facilitating their participation in court proceedings; and

- 1 Pay any costs of administering the Program.
