A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2                                   **Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Suitland Citizens**  
3                                   **Association**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of  
5 \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of  
6 Suitland Citizens Association, Inc. for certain development or improvement  
7 purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; and providing  
8 generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

9       SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
10 MARYLAND, That:

11       (1)       The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on  
12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince  
13 George's County - Suitland Citizens Association Loan of 2000 in the total principal  
14 amount of \$200,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of  
15 State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public  
16 Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of  
17 the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

18       (2)       The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as  
19 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under  
20 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

21       (3)       The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer  
22 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and  
23 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then  
24 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the  
25 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable  
26 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of Suitland  
27 Citizens Association, Inc. for the construction, renovation, repair, reconstruction, and  
28 capital equipping of the Suitland Citizens Association building, located at 4729 Silver  
29 Hill Road, Suitland, Maryland 20746.

30       (4)       An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in  
31 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and

1 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years  
2 after the date of issuance of the bonds.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
4 June 1, 2000.
