1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Creation of a State Debt - Cecil County - Town of Elkton

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- $\frac{$2,325,870}{}$   $\frac{$750,000}{}$ , the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Mayor and
- 5 Commissioners of the Town of Elkton for certain development or improvement
- 6 purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; and providing
- 7 generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
- 8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 9 MARYLAND, That:
- 10 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 11 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Cecil County
- 12 Town of Elkton Loan of 2000 in the total principal amount of \$2,325,870 \$750,000.
- 13 This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general
- 14 obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued,
- 15 sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance
- 16 and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 17 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 18 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 19 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 20 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 21 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 22 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 23 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 24 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 25 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Mayor and Commissioners of the

- 1 Town of Elkton for the placement of underground utilities, to be located beneath Main
- 2 Street in Elkton, Maryland.
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 June 1, 2000.
