- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 12 Article 33 Election Code
- 13 8-201.
- 14 (a) (1) There shall be a statewide primary election in every even-numbered 15 year.
- 16 (2) A primary election shall be held:
- 17 (i) In the year in which the Governor is elected, on the second
- 18 Tuesday after the first Monday in September; and
- 19 (ii) In the year in which the President of the United States is
- 20 elected, on the first Tuesday in March.
- 21 (b) [In] BEGINNING IN THE YEAR 2004, IN Baltimore City, there shall be a
- 22 primary election for municipal offices on the second Tuesday following the first
- 23 Monday in September in the year [following the election of the Governor] THAT THE
- 24 PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES IS ELECTED.

- 8 November in the year following the election of the Governor] SAME DAY AS THE
- 9 GENERAL ELECTION FOR PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 11 October 1, 2000.
