2 State Personnel - Payment of Wages - Direct Deposit

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Treasurer, on warrant of the State
- 4 Comptroller, to pay a wage by direct deposit; providing that the payment of
- 5 certain wages by direct deposit shall be made in accordance with regulations
- 6 adopted by the State Treasurer, with the concurrence of the State Comptroller;
- 7 providing that the State Treasurer may not require the payment of wages by
- 8 direct deposit for certain employees; providing for guidance on the granting of
- 9 exemptions; and generally relating to the payment of wages of State employees
- and officers.

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 Article - State Personnel and Pensions

19 2-405.

- 20 (A) IN ADDITION TO THE PAYMENT OF WAGES BY CASH OR CHECK, THE STATE
- 21 TREASURER, ON WARRANT OF THE STATE COMPTROLLER, MAY PAY A WAGE BY
- 22 DIRECT DEPOSIT.
- 23 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION. THE
- 24 PAYMENT OF WAGES BY DIRECT DEPOSIT SHALL BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH
- 25 REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE STATE TREASURER, WITH THE CONCURRENCE OF
- 26 THE STATE COMPTROLLER.

- 1 (C) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE STATE TREASURER UNDER 2 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION:
- 3 (1) MAY NOT REQUIRE THE PAYMENT OF WAGES BY DIRECT DEPOSIT
- 4 FOR ANY EMPLOYEE HIRED PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE REGULATIONS;
- 5 AND
- 6 (2) SHALL ALLOW AN EMPLOYEE TO REQUEST AN EXEMPTION TO THE 7 PAYMENT OF WAGES BY DIRECT DEPOSIT.
- 8 (D) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE
- 9 STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM RELATING TO PAYMENT OF WAGES BY DIRECT DEPOSIT
- 10 SHALL PROVIDE GUIDANCE FOR THE CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH AN
- 11 EXEMPTION TO PAYMENT OF WAGES BY DIRECT DEPOSIT MAY BE GRANTED.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 13 effect October 1, 2000.
