A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Caroline County - Sheriff's Salary - Increase**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Sheriff of Caroline County; providing for
4 the application of this Act; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally
5 relating to the salary of the Sheriff of Caroline County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

14 2-309.

15 (g) (1) The Sheriff of Caroline County shall receive an annual salary of
16 [\$45,000 in 1995 and in each subsequent year] \$49,500.

17 (2) The Sheriff may appoint deputy sheriffs and other personnel in
18 accordance with the County budget.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
20 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
21 apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Caroline County in office on the
22 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
23 compensation of the Sheriff of Caroline County shall take effect at the beginning of
24 the next following term of office.

25 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 2002.
