11 12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 16	(g) (1) The Sheriff of Caroline County shall receive an annual salary of [\$45,000 in 1995 and in each subsequent year] \$49,500.

	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Caroline County in office on the
