A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Wicomico County - Alcoholic Beverages - Wine Tasting Permit

- 3 FOR the purpose of creating in Wicomico County a wine tasting (WT) permit;
- 4 specifying certain persons to be eligible to be issued a WT permit; establishing a
- 5 certain permit fee; creating certain procedures for the application, renewal, and
- 6 the granting or denial of a WT permit; establishing a notice requirement;
- 7 restricting in certain ways the amount of wine that may be served and bottles
- 8 that may be opened at a wine tasting or sampling event; and generally relating
- 9 to wine tasting or sampling in Wicomico County.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- 18 8-412.
- 19 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WICOMICO COUNTY.
- 20 (B) (1) A WINE TASTING (WT) PERMIT MAY ONLY BE ISSUED TO A HOLDER
- 21 OF A CLASS A BEER AND WINE (OFF-SALE) LICENSE.
- 22 (2) A WT PERMIT MAY BE ISSUED ONLY FOR ON-PREMISES
- 23 CONSUMPTION.
- 24 (C) THE ANNUAL PERMIT FEE IS \$150.
- 25 (D) (1) AN APPLICATION FOR A WT PERMIT SHALL BE MADE ON A FORM
- 26 THAT THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FOR WICOMICO COUNTY PROVIDES.

- 1 (2) A RENEWAL OF A WT PERMIT MAY BE MADE AT THE TIME THE CLASS 2 A BEER AND WINE (OFF-SALE) LICENSE IS RENEWED.
- 3 (3) WITHOUT A HEARING, THE BOARD MAY APPROVE OR DENY AN 4 APPLICATION FOR A WT PERMIT.
- 5 (4) IF AN APPLICATION FOR A WT PERMIT IS DENIED, ON THE 6 APPLICANT'S REQUEST THE BOARD SHALL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO RECONSIDER 7 THE APPLICATION.
- 8 (E) A WT PERMIT HOLDER SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD IN WRITING AT LEAST 5 9 BUSINESS DAYS BEFORE EACH WINE TASTING OR SAMPLING EVENT.
- $10~{\rm (F)}~{\rm (1)}~{\rm A}$ WT PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOT MIX THE CONTENTS OF ONE BOTTLE $11~{\rm WITH}$ ANOTHER.
- 12 (2) ONCE OPENED, EACH BOTTLE USED FOR THE WINE TASTING OR 13 SAMPLING EVENT SHALL BE MARKED THAT IT IS TO BE USED ONLY FOR THAT 14 EVENT.
- 15 (3) A WT PERMIT HOLDER SHALL DESTROY EACH BOTTLE AFTER IT IS 16 EMPTY.
- 17 (G) A WT PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOT:
- 18 (1) SERVE TO ANY PERSON FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING PURPOSES MORE 19 THAN 2 OUNCES FROM EACH BRAND NOR MORE THAN SIX SAMPLES PER DAY;
- 20 (2) HAVE OPEN MORE THAN SIX BOTTLES OF WINE AT ONCE;
- 21 (3) HOLD WINE TASTING OR SAMPLING EVENTS ON MORE THAN 15 DAYS 22 DURING EACH PERMIT PERIOD; AND
- 23 (4) CONDUCT WINE TASTING OR SAMPLING FROM A DRIVE-THROUGH 24 WINDOW.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 2000.
