- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages
- 20 5-201.
- 21 (a) (1) A Class B beer and light wine license shall be issued by the license
- 22 issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located. The holder
- 23 may keep for sale and sell beer and light wines at retail at any hotel or restaurant, at
- 24 the place described in the license, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere.
- 25 (2) The annual fee shall be paid to the local collecting agent before any
- 26 license is issued.
- 27 (x) In Wicomico County the annual license fee is [\$275] \$400.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2000.
