17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

2 5-201.

3 (a) (1) A Class B beer and light wine license shall be issued by the license
4 issuing authority of the county in which the place of business is located. The holder
5 may keep for sale and sell beer and light wines at retail at any hotel or restaurant, at
6 the place described in the license, for consumption on the premises or elsewhere.

7 (2) The annual fee shall be paid to the local collecting agent before any
8 license is issued.

9 (x) In Wicomico County the annual license fee is [~~\$275~~] \$400.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2000.
