FOR the purpose of establishing that a certain alcoholic beverages licensee or a certain alcoholic beverages applicant may appeal a decision of a local alcoholic beverages licensing board to the circuit court of the county under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the appeal of a final decision of a local alcoholic beverages licensing board.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (a) The decision of a local licensing board, in approving, suspending, revoking 18 and restricting, or refusing to approve, suspend, revoke or restrict [any] A license, or 19 A licensee, shall be subject to appeal in the manner provided in this section.
