- 3 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 4 INDICATED.
- 5 (2) "OBSCENE" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN ARTICLE 27, § 419 OF 6 THE CODE.
- 7 (3) "CHILD PORNOGRAPHY" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN ARTICLE 8 27, § 419A OF THE CODE.
- 9 (B) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2001, EACH COUNTY OR BOARD OF TRUSTEES 10 OF A COUNTY LIBRARY SHALL:
- 11 (1) ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO PREVENT
- 12 MINORS FROM OBTAINING ACCESS THROUGH THE LIBRARY, BY MEANS OF THE
- 13 INTERNET, THE WORLD WIDE WEB, USENET, OR ANY OTHER INTERACTIVE
- 14 COMPUTER SERVICE TO MATERIALS THAT ARE OBSCENE OR CONSTITUTE CHILD
- 15 PORNOGRAPHY-; AND
