6 this Act; and generally relating to school crossing guards directing traffic.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Transportation**

15 21-107.

16 (A) A SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD MAY DIRECT OR REGULATE TRAFFIC IN A
17 ~~SCHOOL~~ SAFETY ZONE.

18 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY DISOBEY ANY LAWFUL ORDER OR
19 DIRECTION OF A SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD EXERCISING THE AUTHORITY GRANTED
20 IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2000.
