- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That, under the provisions of Article 33 Election Code of the
- 12 Annotated Code of Maryland, the Prince George's County Board of Elections, in
- 13 consultation with the State Board of Elections, shall prepare and include on the ballot
- 14 for the November general election of 2000 the following questions:
- 15 "Revenues for Schools and Police Services
- Do you favor amending the Tax Reform Initiative by Marylanders (TRIM) in §
- 17 817B of the Prince George's County Charter and mandating new revenues for
- 18 improving schools and police services?"

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Prince George's County Board of Elections and the Prince George's County Council shall do those things necessary and proper to place each question on the ballot prepared for the November general election of 2000, so that each participating voter in the County may have the opportunity to cast a vote on each question. Each question shall be proposed, presented, tallied, and reported in general accordance with the provisions of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland. The vote on each question is advisory only.
