- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article 2B Alcoholic Beverages

- 16 (a) In Baltimore City an amusement license shall authorize the holder thereof
- 17 to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at all hours except between the hours
- 18 of 2 o'clock a.m. and 6 o'clock a.m. of each day.
- 19 (b) No sales shall be permitted by the holder of a Class D, beer, wine and
- 20 liquor license (without amusement permit) between the hours of 1 a.m. on Sunday
- 21 and 6 a.m. the following day.
- 22 (C) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY
- 23 RESTRICT BY REGULATION THE HOURS FOR SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY
- 24 ANY LICENSEE ON ANY DAY BETWEEN 6 A.M. AND 9 A.M.
- 25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 26 October 1, 2000.
