A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages - Restrictions on Hours of Sale**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners
4 to restrict certain hours for sale of alcoholic beverages by any licensee in
5 Baltimore City on any day; and generally relating to the hours for sale of
6 alcoholic beverages in Baltimore City.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 11-503.

16 (a) In Baltimore City an amusement license shall authorize the holder thereof
17 to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at all hours except between the hours
18 of 2 o'clock a.m. and 6 o'clock a.m. of each day.

19 (b) No sales shall be permitted by the holder of a Class D, beer, wine and
20 liquor license (without amusement permit) between the hours of 1 a.m. on Sunday
21 and 6 a.m. the following day.

22 (C) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY
23 RESTRICT BY REGULATION THE HOURS FOR SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY
24 ANY LICENSEE ON ANY DAY BETWEEN 6 A.M. AND 9 A.M.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 2000.
