2 Natural Gas Suppliers - Licensing and Consumer Protection

- 9 prevent the application of certain federal and State laws to certain persons;
- providing that the People's Counsel has certain authority in certain proceedings;
- requiring a gas supplier to provide certain access to certain records as the
- 12 Commission considers necessary; requiring the Commission to adopt certain
- 13 <u>licensing requirements and procedures;</u> requiring the Commission to ensure
- that certain requirements of this Act are met with respect to certain accepted or
- approved restructuring plans or programs; making certain findings of the

- 33 REGULATIONS DESIGNED TO PROTECT CONSUMERS OF GAS SUPPLY AND GAS

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- 1 (C) THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL HAS THE SAME AUTHORITY IN LICENSING,
- 2 COMPLAINT, AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCEEDINGS AS THE PEOPLE'S COUNSEL
- 3 HAS UNDER SUBTITLE 5 OF THIS TITLE AND TITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 4 (D) IN CONNECTION WITH A CONSUMER COMPLAINT OR COMMISSION
- 5 INVESTIGATION UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, A GAS SUPPLIER SHALL PROVIDE TO THE
- 6 COMMISSION ACCESS TO ANY ACCOUNTS, BOOKS, PAPERS, AND DOCUMENTS THAT
- 7 THE COMMISSION CONSIDERS NECESSARY TO RESOLVE A MATTER IN DISPUTE.

- 9 THE COMMISSION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS OR ADOPT ORDERS TO

- 16 business in the State before the effective date of this Act shall be required to obtain a

- 20 suppliers and customers entered into before the effective date of this Act are not
- 21 subject to orders or regulations adopted by the Commission under § 7-604 of the
- 22 Public Utility Companies Article, as enacted by this Act.
- 23 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 July 1, 2000.
