## 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 Article - Education

21 3-903.

22 (a) All actions of the County Board shall be taken [after] AT a public meeting, 23 the record of which shall be made public.

24 (b) This section does not prohibit the County Board from meeting and

25 deliberating in executive session provided that all action of the Board, together with

26 the individual vote of each member, is contained in a public record.

## **SENATE BILL 625**

1(C)(1)NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE COUNTY2BOARD MUST HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING WHENEVER IT MEETS TO TAKE ACTION3RELATING TO THE TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS.

4 (2) THE HEARING SHALL BE HELD ON AT LEAST 10 DAYS' NOTICE, 5 PUBLISHED AT LEAST ONCE IN A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE 6 COUNTY.

7 (3) ALL INTERESTED PERSONS SHALL BE GIVEN AN OPPORTUNITY TO 8 TESTIFY AND PRESENT THEIR VIEWS AT THE HEARING.

9 [(c)] (D) The affirmative vote of the members of the County Board for the 10 passage of a motion by the County Board shall be:

11 (1) 5 members when the student member is voting; or

12 (2) 4 members when the student member is not voting.

13 (E) UPON REQUEST OF A COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION OR PARENTS' GROUP
14 WISHING TO AND OR ELIMINATE A SCHOOL BUS STOP OR SCHOOL BUS ROUTE, THE
15 COUNTY BOARD SHALL:

16 (1) HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS17 CONTAINED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION; AND

18 (2) VOTE ON THE MATTER RAISED BY THE COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION 19 OR PARENTS' GROUP.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2000.

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
