3 FOR the purpose of adding Caroline County to those counties that may regulate the
4 possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages on public property or
5 highways; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to the
6 regulation of alcoholic beverages in Caroline County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

20 19-101.

21 (a) A person may not:

22 (1) Be intoxicated and endanger the safety of another person or property;
23 or

24 (2) Be intoxicated or drink any alcoholic beverage in a public place and
25 cause a public disturbance.

1 19-103.

2 (a) The subdivisions enumerated in this subsection may adopt ordinances or
3 resolutions supplementing this subheading. This includes the authority to regulate
4 possession or consumption of any alcoholic beverage on any public property, property
5 used by the public in general, or on any highway:

- 6 (1) Anne Arundel County;
- 7 (2) Baltimore City;
- 8 (3) Baltimore County;
- 9 [(4) Harford County;
- 10 (5) Prince George's County;
- 11 (6) St. Mary's County;
- 12 (7) Cecil County;
- 13 (8) Garrett County; and
- 14 (9) Frederick County.]
- 15 (4) CAROLINE COUNTY;
- 16 (5) CECIL COUNTY;
- 17 (6) FREDERICK COUNTY;
- 18 (7) GARRETT COUNTY;
- 19 (8) HARFORD COUNTY;
- 20 (9) PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY; AND
- 21 (10) ST. MARY'S COUNTY.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2000.
