A BILL ENTITLED

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- 2 Creation of a State Debt Allegany County Western Maryland Scenic Railroad
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$186,500,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of Western Maryland
- 6 Scenic Railroad Development Corporation for certain development or
- 7 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject
- 8 to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and
- 9 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That:

- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Allegany
- 14 County Western Maryland Scenic Railroad Loan of 2000 in a total principal amount
- 15 equal to the lesser of (i) \$186,500 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in
- 16 accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale,
- 17 and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board
- 18 of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through
- 19 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 20 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 21 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 22 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 23 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 24 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 25 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 26 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 27 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 28 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of Western
- 29 Maryland Scenic Railroad Development Corporation (referred to hereafter in this Act
- 30 as "the grantee") for the acquisition of a turntable for, and the repair, reconstruction,
- 31 and renovation of a steam engine and passenger cars for, the Western Maryland
- 32 Scenic Railroad, based in Cumberland, Allegany County, Maryland.

- 1 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 2 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 3 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 4 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 5 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the 6 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a 7 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 8 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 9 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property. The fund may
- 10 consist of in kind contributions, including computer and radio equipment, or funds
- 11 expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount
- 12 of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the
- 13 Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final.
- 14 The grantee has until June 1, 2002, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of
- 15 Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is
- 16 presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to
- 17 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching
- 18 fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan
- 19 in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works
- 20 shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 June 1, 2000.
