1 AN ACT concerning

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Creation of a State Debt - Allegany County - Western Maryland Scenic Railroad

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$186,500

 $\frac{175,000}{1000}$, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of Western

6 Maryland Scenic Railroad Development Corporation for certain development or

7 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject

8 to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and

9 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Allegany
County - Western Maryland Scenic Railroad Loan of 2000 in a total principal amount
equal to the lesser of (i) \$186,500 \$175,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund
provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the
issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a
resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance
with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and

20 Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

(2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
§ 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

24 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer 25 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and

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1 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then

2 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the

3 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable

4 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of Western

5 Maryland Scenic Railroad Development Corporation (referred to hereafter in this Act

6 as "the grantee") for the acquisition of <u>land and</u> a turntable for, and the repair,

7 reconstruction, and renovation of a steam engine, diesel engines, and passenger cars

8 for, the Western Maryland Scenic Railroad, based in Cumberland, Allegany County,9 Maryland.

10 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 11 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 12 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 13 after the date of issuance of the bonds.

14 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the 15 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a

16 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either

17 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or

18 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property. The fund may

19 consist of in kind contributions, including computer and radio equipment real

20 property, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any

21 dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify

22 as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the

23 Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2002, to present evidence

24 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If

25 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of

26 the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the 27 amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act.

27 amount of the matching fund shar be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. 28 Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the

29 Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 June 1, 2000.
