- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND COMPLEX" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN
- 18 REGULATION 14A ADOPTED UNDER THE SECURITIES EXCHANGE ACT OF 1934.
- 19 [(a)] (B) This section applies to a corporation that is an investment company,
- 20 as defined by the Investment Company Act of 1940.
- 21 [(b)] (C) [A]SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, A director of a
- 22 corporation who with respect to the corporation is not an interested person, as defined
- 23 by the Investment Company Act of 1940, shall be deemed to be independent and
- 24 disinterested when making any determination or taking any action as a director.
- 25 (D) SERVICE AS A DIRECTOR OR TRUSTEE, OR THE RECEIPT OF FEES OR
- 26 OTHER COMPENSATION FOR SERVICE AS A DIRECTOR OR TRUSTEE, OF ONE OR MORE
- 27 CORPORATIONS, TRUSTS, OR OTHER ENTITIES OF A FUND COMPLEX, INCLUDING

- 2 CONSIDERED IN DETERMINING WHETHER A DIRECTOR IS INDEPENDENT OR

- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 5 construed retroactively and shall be applied to and interpreted to affect any case filed
- 6 on or after January 30, 1998.
- 7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 June 1, 2000.
