- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article 33 - Election Code 2 2-207. 3 (a) (1) This section applies to each employee of a local board.
