	CHAPTER	

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Frederick County - Weinberg Center for the Arts

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$450,000
- \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Mayor and Board of 4
- 5 Aldermen of the City of Frederick for certain development or improvement
- purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a 6
- requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; providing 7
- that the grantee must grant and convey a certain easement covenant to the 8
- Maryland Historical Trust; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of 9
- 10 bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11

- 12 MARYLAND, That:
- 13 The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 14 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Frederick
- 15 County Weinberg Center for the Arts Loan of 2000 in a total principal amount equal
- 16 to the lesser of (i) \$450,000 \$200,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided
- 17 in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance,
- 18 sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the 19 Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117
- 20 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of
- 21 the Code.
- 22 The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 23 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 24 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

- 1 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer 2 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and 3 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then 4 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the 5 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable 6 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the 7 City of Frederick (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the 8 acquisition, renovation, repair, reconstruction, and capital equipping of a facility 9 located at 20 West Patrick Street in Frederick, Maryland, for the Weinberg Center for 10 the Arts.
- 11 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 12 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and 13 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 14 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 15 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the
- 23 Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2002, to present evidence 24 satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If
- 25 satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of
- 26 the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the
- 27 amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act.
- 28 Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the
- 29 Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 30 (6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey 31 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement covenant to the 32 extent of its interest:
- 33 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust; 34 and
- 35 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 35 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic 36 structures.
- 37 (b) The easement covenant must be in form and substance acceptable to 38 the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the
- 39 Trust.
- 40 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 41 June 1, 2000.
