- 15 (b) The provisions of this subtitle do not apply to:
- 16 (4) Any person who:
- 17 (i) Makes [3] NINE or fewer mortgage loans per calendar year; and
- 18 (ii) Brokers no more than one mortgage loan per calendar year;
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
