- 17 19-1410.

18 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE A SITE VISIT AND CONDUCT A FULL 19 SURVEY OF EACH LICENSED NURSING HOME AT LEAST FOUR TIMES PER CALENDAR 20 YEAR.

21 (B) ALL SURVEYS SHALL BE UNANNOUNCED.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

23 October 1, 2000.
