14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9 (8) ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR EXEMPTING ORGANIC FARMERS 10 FROM PESTICIDE APPLICATIONS.

(E) MEMBERS OF THE TASK FORCE SHALL SERVE WITHOUT COMPENSATION
 EXCEPT THAT THE MEMBERS MAY BE REIMBURSED FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE
 STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

14 (F) THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH
15 AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL PROVIDE STAFF SUPPORT FOR THE TASK FORCE TO
16 THE EXTENT POSSIBLE WITHIN EXISTING BUDGETED RESOURCES.

(G) THE TASK FORCE SHALL ISSUE A FINAL REPORT OF ITS FINDINGS,
 RECOMMENDATIONS, AND COMPREHENSIVE STRATEGY TO THE GOVERNOR AND,
 SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL
 ASSEMBLY ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2001 2000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 October June 1, 2000. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 8 months
 and, at the end of May 31, 2002 2001, with no further action required by the General

24 Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

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
