2 Maryland After-School Opportunity Act - Appropriation - Requirements

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to include an appropriation of a certain
- 4 amount for a certain fiscal year for the Maryland After-School Opportunity
- 5 Fund; providing that a certain amount of the total appropriation shall be subject
- 6 to certain matching fund requirements; prohibiting disbursements to recipients
- that exceed a certain amount; and generally relating to the Maryland
- 8 After-School Opportunity Act.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE AN APPROPRIATION OF \$20 MILLION IN
- 19 THE STATE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002 FOR THE MARYLAND AFTER-SCHOOL
- 20 OPPORTUNITY FUND.
- 21 (B) THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE SHALL DISBURSE \$10 MILLION OF THE
- 22 AMOUNT APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2002 PURSUANT TO THE
- 23 PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 24 (C) \$10 MILLION OF THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND FOR
- 25 FISCAL YEAR 2002 SHALL BE DISBURSED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
- 26 SUBTITLE AND SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

- 1 (2) EACH RECIPIENT OF FUNDS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL 2 PROVIDE AND EXPEND A MATCHING FUND EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS THAT
- 3 THE RECIPIENT IS AWARDED.
- 4 (3) THE TOTAL GRANTS AWARDED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION TO ALL
- 5 THE RECIPIENTS IN ANY COUNTY, INCLUDING BALTIMORE CITY, MAY NOT EXCEED
- 6 \$2,500,000.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 8 effect October 1, 2000.
