A BILL ENTITLED

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- Article Health General 13
- 14 2-302.
- 15 The funding required in the State budget for local health services, (a)
- exclusive of special fund and federal appropriations, shall be at least the amount set
- forth in subsection (b) of this section.
- 18 (b) The funding shall be:
- 19 (1) \$41.0 million for Fiscal Year 1997; and
- For Fiscal Year 1998 and each subsequent fiscal year, the amount of 20 (2)
- 21 funding for Fiscal Year 1997 adjusted for:
- 22 Inflation, as measured by the Consumer Price Index - all urban (i)
- 23 consumers for the second preceding fiscal year, calculated by the U.S. Department of
- 24 Commerce; [and]
- 25 Population growth, as measured by the growth in the total (ii)
- 26 population of the State of Maryland for the second preceding fiscal year, according to

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- 1 the most recent statistics available through the Department of Health and Mental 2 Hygiene; AND IN ADDITION TO THE ADJUSTMENT UNDER ITEMS (I) AND (II) OF (III)4 THIS ITEM, THE SUM OF THE FOLLOWING: IF THERE IS A GENERAL SALARY INCREASE FOR STATE 6 EMPLOYEES INCLUDED IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR A FISCAL YEAR, THE AMOUNT 7 ADJUSTED UNDER ITEMS (I) AND (II) OF THIS ITEM MULTIPLIED BY 80% TIMES THE 8 PERCENT OF THE GENERAL SALARY INCREASE: 9 IF THERE IS A COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT FOR STATE 10 EMPLOYEES INCLUDED IN THE STATE BUDGET FOR A FISCAL YEAR, THE AMOUNT 11 ADJUSTED UNDER ITEMS (I) AND (II) OF THIS ITEM MULTIPLIED BY 80% TIMES THE 12 PERCENT OF THE COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT; AND 13 3. IF THERE IS A SPECIAL SALARY ADJUSTMENT THAT 14 AFFECTS A STATE POSITION CLASSIFICATION OR CLASSIFICATION SERIES THAT IS 15 HISTORICALLY USED BY A LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT, THE AMOUNT ADJUSTED 16 UNDER ITEMS (I) AND (II) OF THIS ITEM MULTIPLIED BY 80% TIMES 1%. For Fiscal Year 1997, no subdivision may receive less State funding 17 18 for local health services under this section than that subdivision received in Fiscal 19 Year 1996. 20 For Fiscal Year 1998 and each subsequent fiscal year, no subdivision 21 may receive less State funding for local health services under this section than that 22 subdivision received in Fiscal Year 1997. 23 (3)The Secretary shall, in consultation with local health department 24 directors, adopt regulations to guide the distribution of the funding required under 25 this section. The regulations shall give consideration to appropriate measures of
